

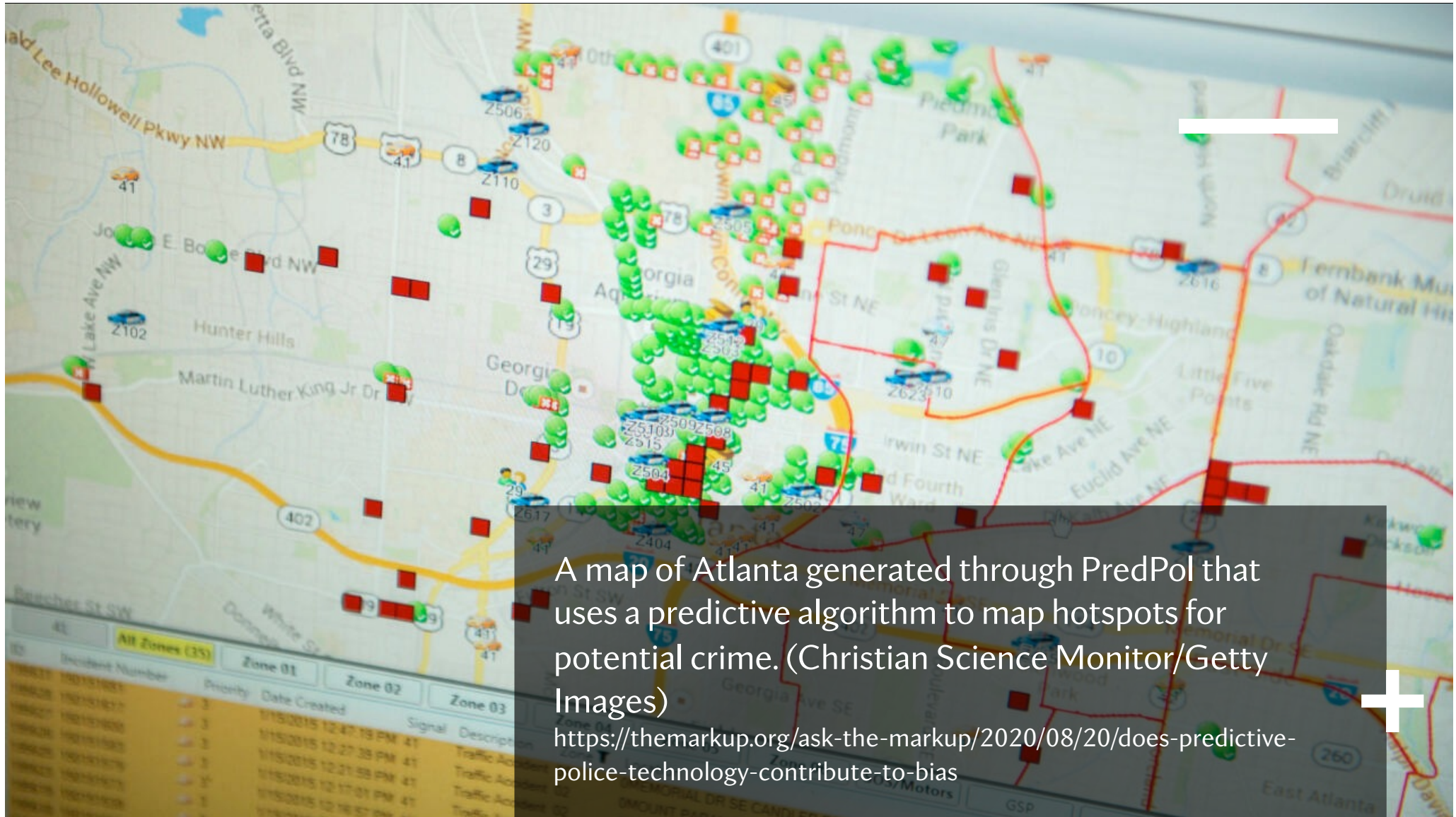

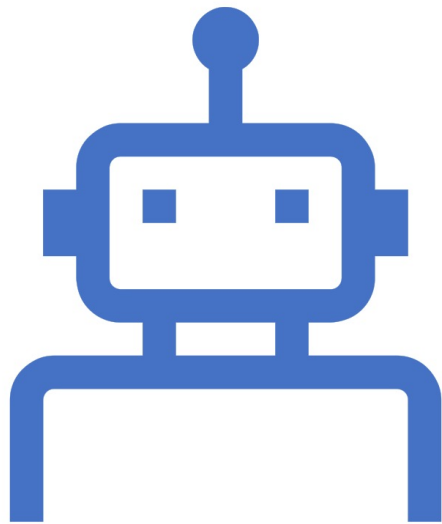

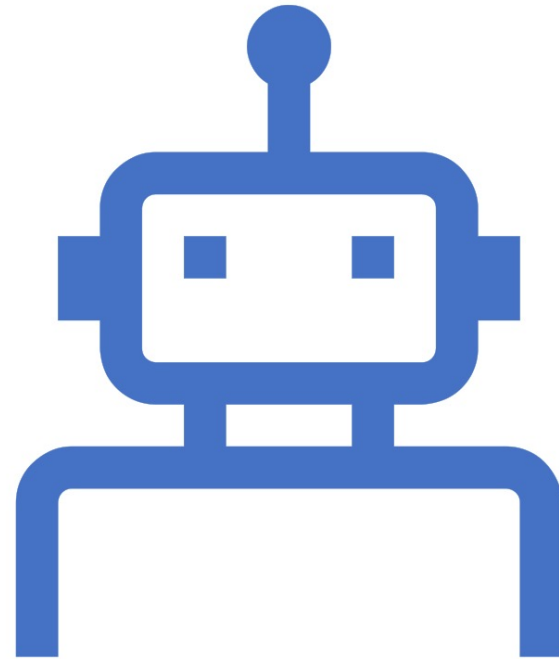


Most AI Ethics incorporate civil society inclusion/participation.

What does civil society participation in AI look like?

- Stakeholder Engagement
- Public feedback
- Mini-publics (e.g., citizen juries)
- Participatory Design (and model cards)
- Co-production/co-creation

- Not necessarily geographic

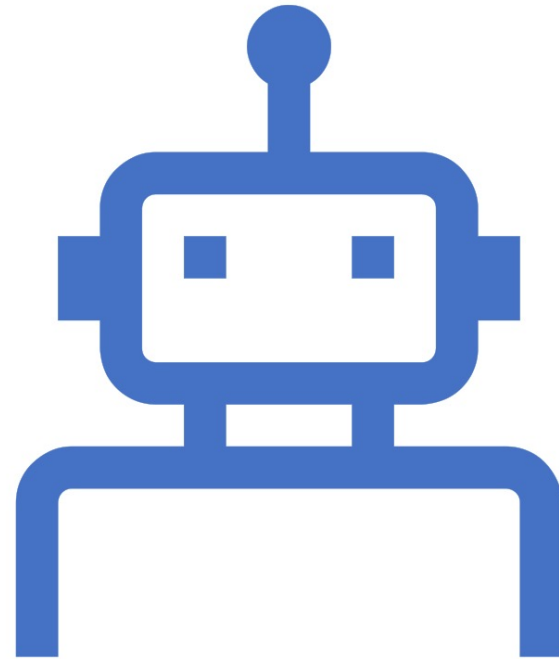


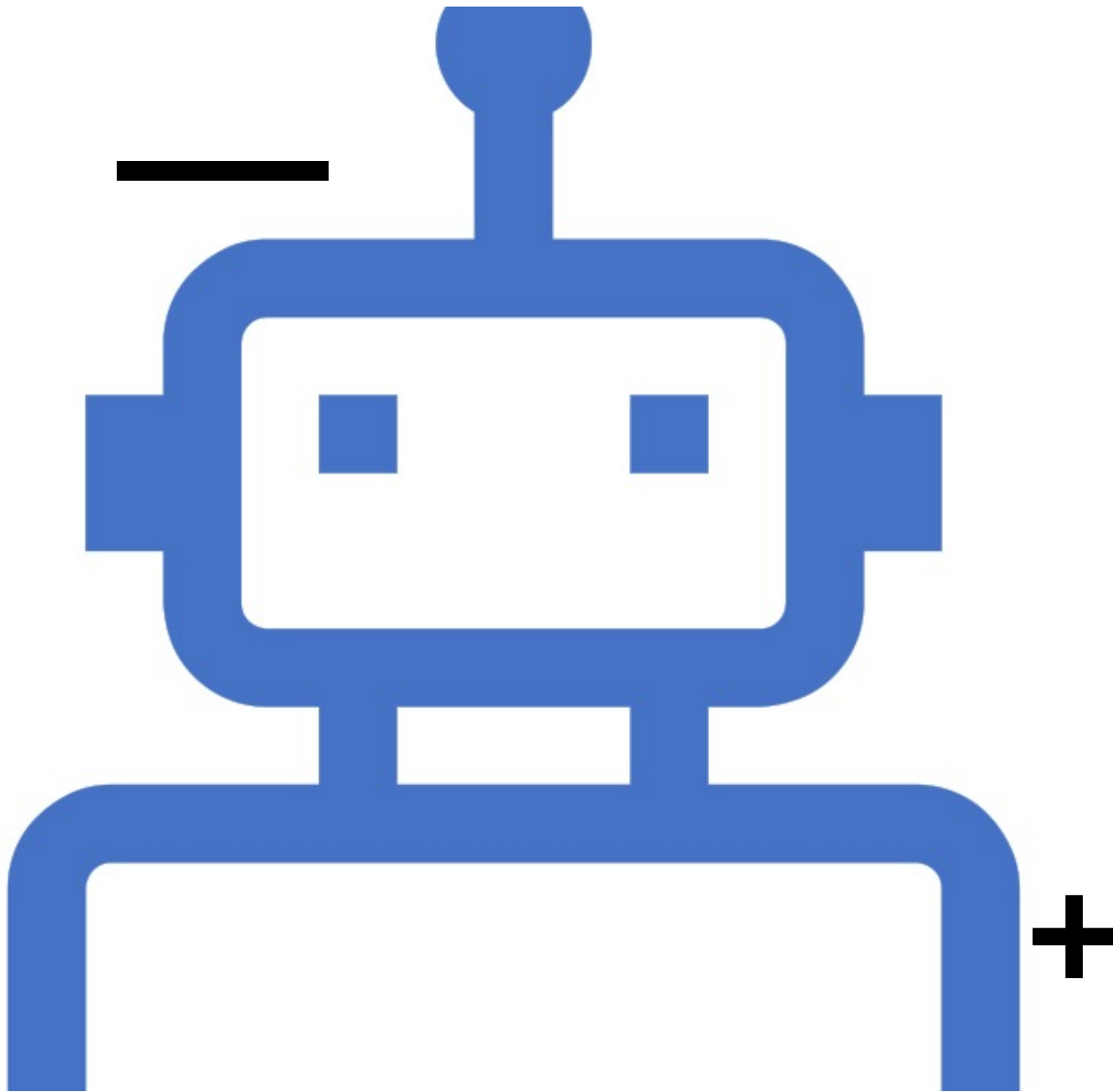
What about those stakeholders?

Not all stakeholders are the same.





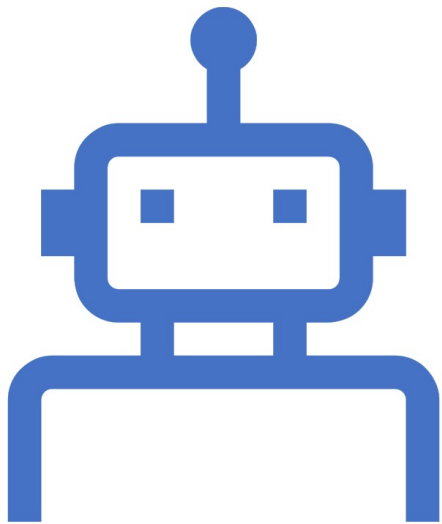
Co-production, co-

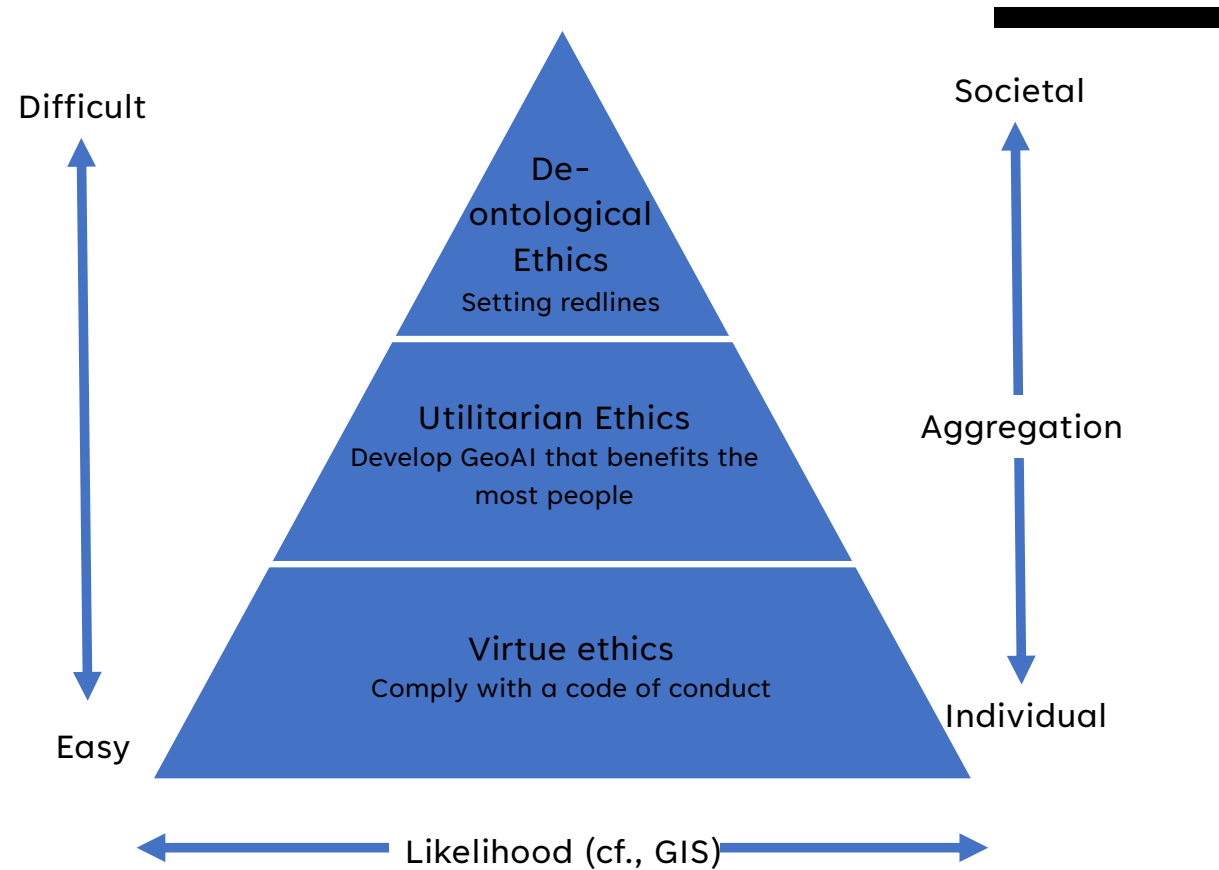
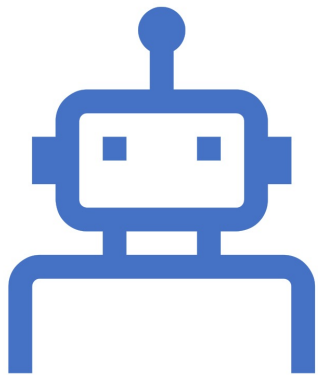
What about chatbots or passive harvesting?

Non-civil society actors are acting on behalf of civil society and determining algorithmic justice (“Responsible AI”).

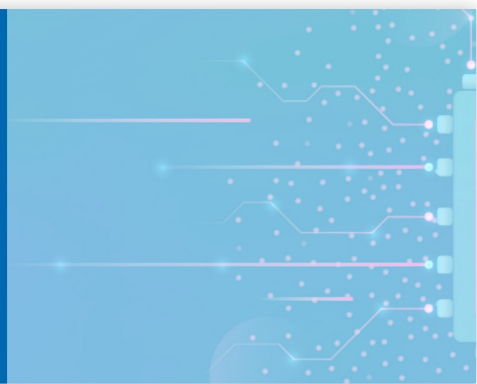


Applied Ethics Triangle for GeoAI

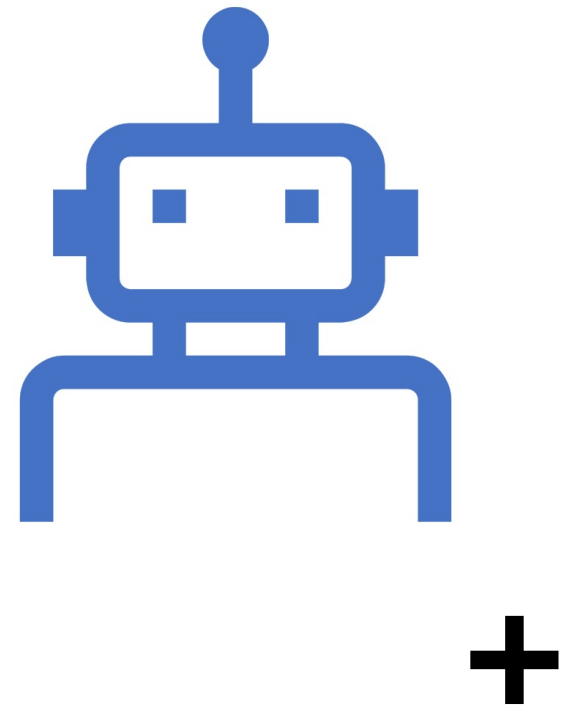
